NIIT Foundation (NF) is a not-for-profit education society set up by the promoters of NIIT in 2004. Its mission is to positively impact the underprivileged people of the country through educational initiatives and skill development programs to increase employability. To achieve this, NF runs various grassroots initiatives in partnership with other corporations. Skill development centers are set up in urban and rural areas that offer placement support to all eligible students. Additionally, we provide digital and financial literacy programs to bridge rural and urban gaps. Hole-in-the-Wall Learning stations have been installed to support early introduction and familiarity with technology for school-going children in an attempt to bridge the digital divide.



NF also supports other NGOs to build their capacity and reach a larger number of beneficiaries. NF has been delivering projects as per Section 135 of the Companies Act 2013. The projects reach out to a wide range of beneficiaries from the age group of 6 to 60 years old. The skilling and education engagement models are targeted towards underprivileged & underserved youth/children, women, specially-abled/PWDs, and LGBTQIA+ community across 28 states and 8 Union Territories.

NIIT Foundation's vision is to create a deep-demonstrable impact in every community we work in. In order to do that we use skilling and educational initiatives to reach every underserved individual in the remotest of places. The Values that guide us include:

Implementation Models



Hole-in-the-Wall Learning Stations

A freely accessible computer setup in a playground setting that looks like an ATM kiosk, pre-loaded with qualitative, interactive, digital e-learning content, utilising self-exploration, and play-way methodology. Designed for children in the age group of 5-14 years to enhance digital literacy, it has reached 39,370 students. There are currently our 264 HiWEL setups are functioning and enhancing the learning journeys of children.



NReach & Schools

NIIT Foundation's NReach Program empowers 250+ NGO partners to deliver NIIT Foundation's career and foundation programs to 66,000+ beneficiaries. School students benefit from multi-year programs in Computer Concepts, Personality Development, and English. Special life skills programs, using Genuine Contact Methodology, are offered, while enhancing local school faculty skills remains integral.



Digital Bus

Solar powered, mobile classrooms called the Digital Bus are a key component of our Digital Literacy programs. Programs in the Digital Bus teach women and youth, especially in remote and isolated locations, to use a computer to improve their life including the use of emails, the internet, and applications like MS Office. Currently, 8 Digital buses are operational and have impacted close to 50000 beneficiaries out of which 29305 are males and 18714 are females.



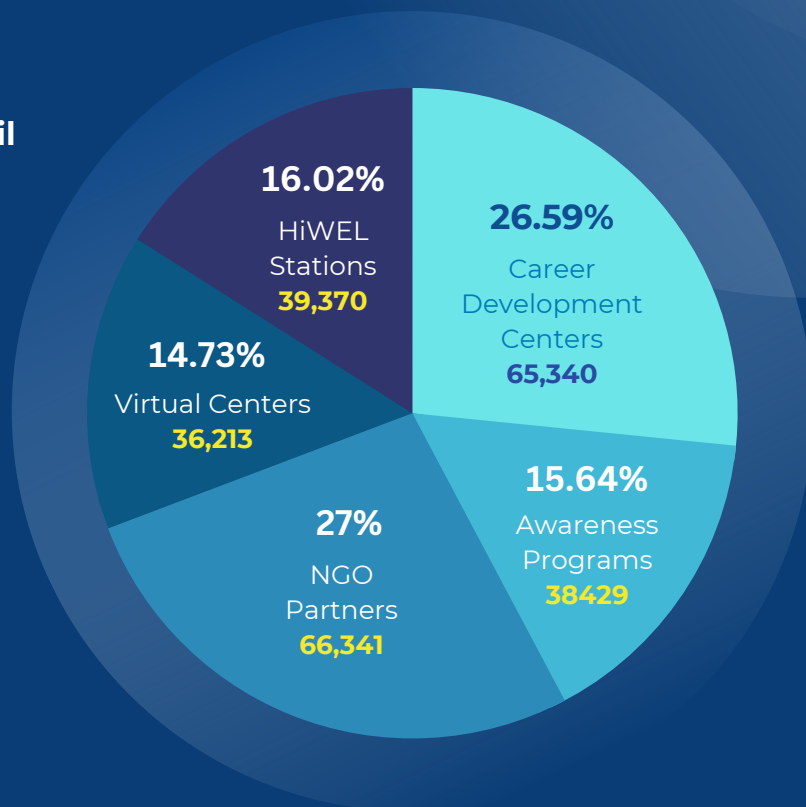
Skill Centers

Skill Centers deliver quality skilling programs in rural as well as urban locations to improve employability opportunities for beneficiaries. Well-qualified facilitators deliver career-oriented programs such as Cybersecurity, Retail, BPO, Logistics, Web Development, and others. We have reached 1,89,539 students through our 35 Career Development Centers and 208 Digital Literacy Centers.

Beneficiaries Impacted

In FY23, NIIT Foundation enrolled **1.65 Mil** and certified **1.38 Mil** beneficiaries in various programs. These include about **58,000** youth who completed their career programs, and we were able to place about **41,500 in productive employment**. This year our efforts have extended to positively impact the LGBTQIA+ community, people with special needs, and senior citizens.

With a total of **8.46 million enrollments** and **1.7 lakh successful placements** to date, NIIT Foundation has been able to reach 79% of districts in India in FY23.

Glimpses of major Activities

Cyber Security Workshop

With an exponential increase in the people using internet to transact their work, cyber security has become a very important focus area for skilling. With Support from CISCO CSR, NF is implementing cyber security training to impact 1 million beneficiaries over a 3 year period. As part of the project, NF held exclusive workshops to teach the basics of Cyber security to 350 girl students and 66 BSF Jawans from technical and non-technical backgrounds.



Financial Literacy for Drivers

NIIT Foundation empowers families and individuals to break the cycle of poverty with a nationwide financial literacy program for drivers - men & women. Workshops cover budgeting, banking apps, payments, and accessing Government schemes, benefiting over 100,000 people. This impactful initiative equips them with essential skills for a brighter future.



STEM for Girls Program

The aim of this program is twofold - one, to encourage young girls to adopt a STEM mindset from a young age and two, to enable women from non-STEM backgrounds in IT and ITES-related careers. Girls, mainly from rural or semi-urban government schools are trained to equip them with 21st-century skills and technology. It is a learning-based real-life experience that is beyond curriculum and books, keeping in mind the New Education Policy 2020. The major objective of STEM is taking the students far away from Rote learning.

From the Socratic Method to the scientific method and finally the modern principles of design thinking. The project has impacted 58000+ students, across 10 states in a span of three years of implementation.



Digital Buses For Rural Beneficiaries

In alignment with the Digital India vision, NIIT Foundation partners with organizations to launch solar-powered, 5G-enabled Digital buses. These mobile classrooms, furnished with computers, internet, video facilities, and e-course software, target remote Indian areas. Expert trainers deliver custom courses that enhance digital literacy, empower women with technology, and bridge urban-rural education gaps.



The initiative aspires to catalyze a cultural shift through interactive sessions and Life Skill modules, stimulating diverse career paths and entrepreneurship among beneficiaries. This effort resonates with the broader goal of enhancing digital access and education for all segments of society.



Changemaker Life Skills Programs

NIIT Foundation innovatively addresses youth's life skills through the Change Maker Life Skills Program. Using the Genuine Contact Methodology, students (grades 8-12) engage in self-reflection and peer learning, exploring beliefs and choices.

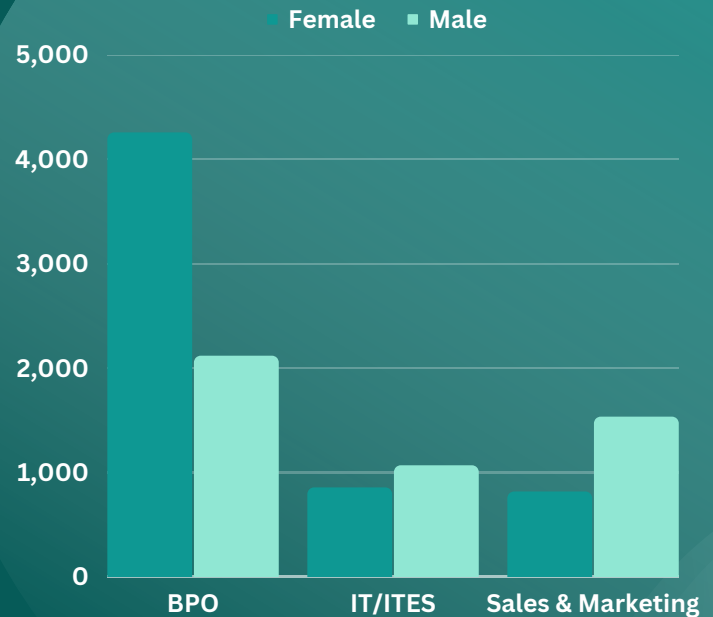


The program fosters personal leadership using simple frameworks. In collaboration with UNICEF, this program empowered government school students in November 2022. This effort has positively **impacted 21,000** students, enhancing their readiness for the future.



Placements

Placements promise transformative gateways to brighter futures, especially for marginalized youth. The goal is to open avenues for these young minds to secure a gateway to financial sovereignty. Exploring horizons in IT/ITES, BPO, Sales & Marketing, BFSI, and logistics, NIIT Foundation deciphers needs and wages, guiding students wisely. FY-2023 saw NIIT Foundation's devotion bloom, **placing 41,594 students** in meaningful roles, each placement a metamorphosis.

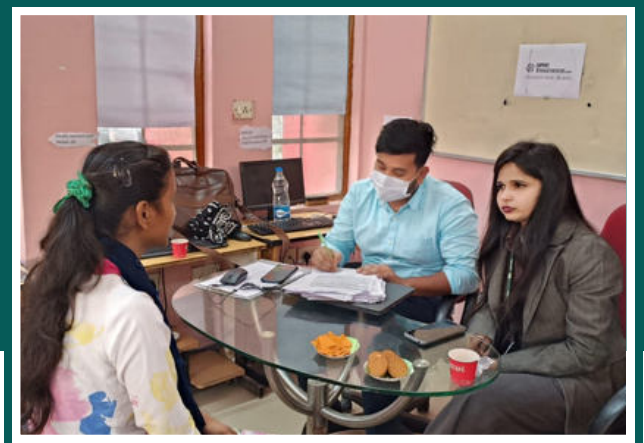


Gender-wise Placement

Women and girls are supported to find suitable placements and are provided with ample opportunities to do so.



- Females lead in BPO with 2 times the placements.
- Males lead in sales & marketing with almost 2 times the placement.
- In IT/ITES placement males lead by a few hundred over females

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

Sustainable Development Goals, also known as global goals are a set of 17 goals, interlinked to serve as an action plan for the peace and prosperity of people and the planet shortly.



- NF programs equip students to improve their skills and take up jobs in the service sector. This income helps their families improve their economic condition thus breaking the vicious circle of poverty



- NF programs are industry recognised and QP aligned. Additionally, the stringent faculty development and certification process ensures that the students experience quality training delivery.



- NF programs are designed to be gender agnostic and everyone is treated with equality. However, to build equity, NF runs special programs that are targeted towards education and economic empowerment of women and girls. Additionally, programs are offered that focus on LGBTQI+ beneficiaries, giving them life skills, technical skills and financial skills required to transition to work life



- NF's flagship program focuses on Employability of youth, training them and finding jobs for them. Over 100000 youth have transitioned to work life in the last 10 years



- NF is working hard for bringing equal opportunities to women and the LGBTQ community through our courses in Basic and Advanced IT in many states. eg. Odisha, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and Uttar Pradesh, etc.



- As a part of various projects running in different regions, along with the students we have been undertaking tree Plantation drives, reducing plastics and paper usage as one of the main activities aligning with many of our projects.



- NF has been collaborating with other organizations to strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development.

NF has launched additional SDG strategies that focus on Gender and Climate Action. Within Gender focus, the task forces led by the NF team are addressing gender stereotypes in society, starting with employees of NF and extending to the education of NF beneficiaries. Strategies for Climate action are currently focusing on reducing paper and plastic within the organization as well as at an individual level. These are long-term strategies and NF is committed to working on these for many more years



Leadership & Capacity Building

NF believes that our students will grow to the extent our team develops and grows. Toward this goal, NF invests in the capacity development of the faculty, managers, and support teams through a published training calendar. The team is encouraged to participate in leading task forces and mentoring circles to address problems that are important to the organization. One such workshop was conducted in Feb 2023 where 100 future leaders of NF gathered to teach and learn together.

Deepanshu Sharma (Kaki)

27 years

Course: Active Basic IT & Professional Edge,
Spoken English & Personality Development
Uttam Nagar, Delhi

A young transgender woman, Kaki (Deepanshu Sharma), found acceptance with her family but not with society. She faced a lot of bullying and harassment in school, the scars which she carries to date, leaving her underconfident and in a shell. Her family of 7 faced severe financial hardships because the sole bread earner, her father, was a factory labourer. Kaki had to drop out of school after 8th standard as they couldn't afford further education for her. She still wished to support her family and began singing devotional songs at Jagratas. Kaki also freelanced as a makeup artist to make ends meet.

Unfortunately, though she was good at her work, she would lose out on clients because her communication skills were not up to the mark. Many preferred to communicate in English which Kaki was not comfortable with. She realized she needed to skill herself if she wanted to have a successful career as a makeup artist. However, whenever she thought of joining a course, her childhood trauma of bullying came back to haunt her and she abandoned thoughts of taking up any course. Her fellow LGBTQIA+ friends shared information about the NIIT Foundation and Connecting Dreams Foundation's special batch for members of their community. Hesitantly, Kaki enrolled in the course.



Initially, she felt shy and awkward. However, as the course progressed, she began opening up and felt confident in her own abilities. Kaki learnt how to speak and communicate well in English, enabling her to pick up more freelance makeup assignments. She also learnt how to use MS Office to design flyers, maintain records, send emailers, draft letters to share, and use the internet to find new makeup techniques and dance videos. She also is actively involved in improving the lives of fellow LGBTQIA+ members and encourages them to take up the course to improve their employability chances.

Kaki is happily pursuing her passions and is earning well from them. Her communication skills and professionalism sets her apart. She expressed her heartfelt gratitude to both - NIIT Foundation and Connecting Dreams Foundation for equipping her with skills to have a brighter future!

Stories of Change

The center head recalls, "In 2015 when Preeti came to the NF CDC Malviya Nagar center, she was a shy young girl, low in confidence but with big dreams. She wanted to become financially independent, become a role model for other girls like her, and most importantly, wanted to make her parents proud."

The 3-month Retail management course not only gave her the technical skills, but the focus on personality development, helped her develop critical life skills. She says that her trainer was extremely motivating and it was because of her encouragement that she began to believe in herself. She worked sincerely in the course and became the only girl in her batch to be placed at Shopper's Stop as a fashion consultant.

She shares that the lessons she learned from NIIT Foundation about professionalism, planning one's career, and being open to new learnings helped her immensely.

In her 4 years at Shopper's Stop, she was promoted 3 times – something she is still very proud of! In the last 8 years of work life, she has worked with international brand names like Nike and Starbucks handling their stores as a store manager. She feels that her association with NIIT Foundation kick-started her career, and her hard work and the support of her family have helped her grow in her career.

Preeti is filled with hope and is excited to see what the future holds for her.

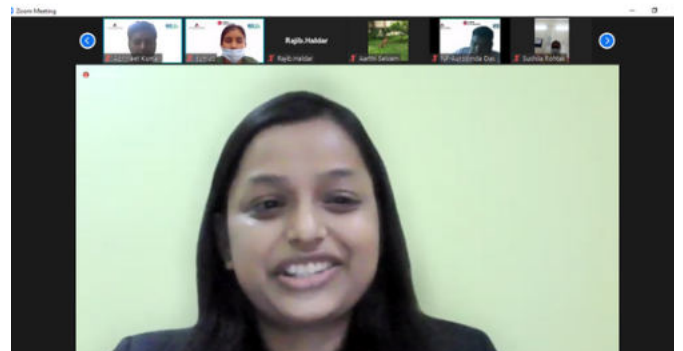

Roshni has been born and brought up in a very small town in Uttar Pradesh. She comes from a very simple background. At the age of 9, she lost her father. She was brought up single-handedly by her mother, who is a homemaker. Growing up, Roshni realised the importance of being financially independent. She completed her mechanical engineering from a government college. There were no placements provided but she was the only one who got a job with a start-up company. It opened her world to IT. Her job required her to know Cyber security. The salary was decent but being the sole breadwinner, it was not enough. She did not earn enough to skill herself. Around this time, Roshni met with a mentor who introduced her to NIIT Foundation and ATC CSR Foundation courses at the Digital Literacy Center in Sarnath, UP.

She used her time in the pandemic and enrolled on the Introduction to Cyber Security and Cisco Certified Network Associate courses. Last year, after completing the courses and receiving multiple offers from reputed companies, she got placed into a US-based MNC. Today Roshni is a successful team lead for a group of account managers at the company.



She has mentored and guided a few girls from her community to up-skill themselves and join her company. Roshni is performing well and her manager is impressed by her. He has assured her that if she inspires more girls to join, they can even look at setting up a branch of the company in Roshni's home town.



It was no less than a dream come true. There are many women who inspired me in my journey like my mother. NIIT Foundation and ATC CSR Foundation gave me an opportunity to grow. I could feel a difference in myself. I got ahead in my life thanks to these courses, for which I thank the team.

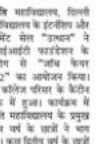
